Dubai's most expensive apartment has gone on sale for £32million – but it won't be ready until 2017.

Sitting on top of the 25-storey ONE at Palm Jumeirah, the luxury penthouse comes with an infinity pool and spa as well as a 12-space garage.

The eight-bedroom suite, which sprawls across 42,477 square-feet, is decked with a staggering 16,641 square-feet of balcony area.
