

Dubai's Priciest Flat For Sale For £32m - But It Won't Be Ready For Two Years

How much would you be willing to pay for a flat before you consider buying a house? £32 million sound too much?

While this 25-storey building will not be finished till 2017 - snapping up this penthouse apartment would give you the kudos of owning the most expensive flat in all of Dubai...not the cheapest place to live.

Just in case you're wondering what you get for your money - the plush penthouse pad comes with an infinity pool and spa, as well as a 12-space garage.

The eight-bedroom suite, which sprawls across 42,477 square-feet, is decked with 16,641 square-feet of balcony area.



As well as a maid's quarter, a kitchen with a separate prep room and wall-to-wall windows, there is a professional barbecue pit and outdoor terrace

The building was designed by New York firm SOMA architects and boasts panoramic views of both the ocean and the high-rise city.



Other facilities include a gym, hair salon and a cinema.

Previously an apartment in Dubai's Burj Khalifa building clinched the title as the city's most expensive property after selling for \$16.3m (£10.62 million).
